

The *Gathering* has become a wonderful summer festival that has brought statewide recognition to the museum and our community. Garst Museum was recognized again as "*Best Historical Museum*" by the readers of *Ohio Magazine*.

The planning is well underway for the 9th *Gathering at Garst* on July 27–28, 2019. As event chairperson, I would like to tell you how Garst Museum and our community have benefited from this event and ask for your continued support. We work hard to make sure the event and the museum are the highest quality possible. We want visitors to have a wonderful experience and return every year--hopefully, with their friends. Your support helps us to market the event to an even greater audience in hopes of sharing our history with more people. Admission is FREE to *The Gathering at Garst*. Your support helps make this possible. There are many expenses related to hosting this event. For example, last year our expenses for advertising, staging, security, restrooms, entertainment, etc. totaled \$33,773. Through sponsorships, grants, vendor fees, parking, pie/ice cream/beer and mercantile sales, we generated \$50,133 and were able to contribute \$16,360, much needed funds, to the museum.

It is *The Gathering at Garst* Committee's hope that this year's event will continue to represent our community in a proud and unique manner that will attract local citizens as well as tourists from surrounding areas. The event will showcase some of the best features that our community has to offer including the Garst Museum, Greenville City Park, and the Darke County Park District.

Their dedication reflects the pride that they have in our community and our history. People give back to the community in different ways. What festival expenses will the money cover?

- Entertainment including family and children's activities
- o Tent rentals

- o Restroom facilities, trash receptacles, and trash pickup

- A \$5 parking fee is charged to those wishing to park on the grounds. This is split 50/50 with the non-profit organization that parks the cars for the event.
- o Pie, ice cream, beer, and wine are sold.

Will an admission fee be charged to enter the festival grounds?

• The normal museum admission fee will still be required to tour the Garst Museum during *The Gathering at Garst*, but admission to the festival is free!

If the festival makes a profit, how will it be used?

 All proceeds go to the Garst Museum (Darke County Historical Society), a 501(c)(3) non-profit institution.
